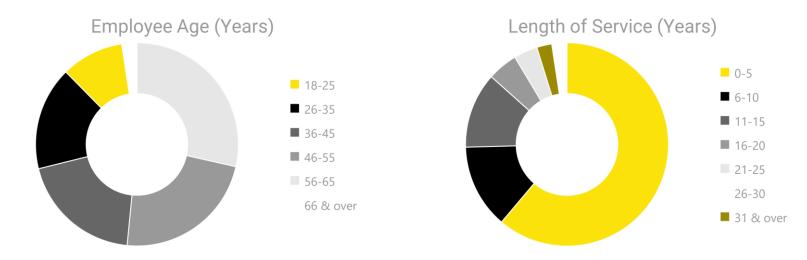

We are proud of our diverse workforce; over 50% of our employees are over the age of 45.

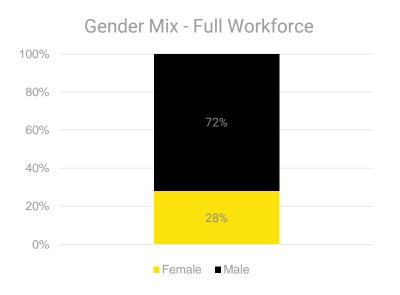


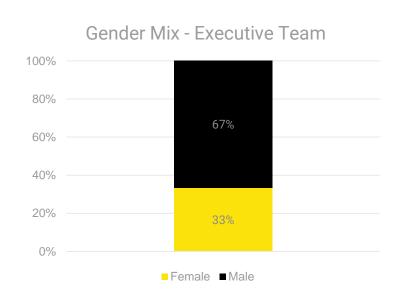
One quarter of our employees have completed over 10 years service.
